The package:

- Preparation of your van before leaving, ensuring windows are defrosted, snow chains and shovels are present and the van is clean, warm and presentable inside and out for our guests.
- Being punctual; arriving on time for pre-arranged collections with our guests, as well as being flexible and willing to do last minute collections.
- Being friendly and approachable towards people of all ages; helping them load their skis into the van, and opening and closing doors for them.
- Communicating with your team to ensure that everyone has collected their guests and no one has been left behind.
- Leaving the van in a presentable state and fuelled up ready to go for your next team mate to take over.

Skills & experience required
