The Role

This is a varied, hands-on role supporting our chalet portfolio over the summer. Because our properties are well maintained going into the season, the volume of reactive maintenance is generally low — most weeks will involve a mix of routine tasks, outdoor upkeep, and occasional repairs as they arise.

You will be part of a well-supported team. More complex or specialist issues are escalated to qualified local tradespeople, and management is always on hand. What we need is someone with a solid maintenance background, sound judgement, and a calm, can-do approach to whatever the day brings.

On quieter days, or when there are no outstanding maintenance tasks, you will be expected to support the wider operations team with general chalet tasks — cleaning, laundry changeovers, and keeping properties well presented for guests.

A company vehicle and tools will be provided for work use across the resort.

Key Responsibilities

Reactive Maintenance

- Responding promptly to maintenance issues raised during guest stays
- Diagnosing and resolving minor to moderate issues efficiently
- Assessing more complex problems and flagging them clearly to management so that qualified local tradespeople can be instructed where needed
- Minimising disruption to the guest experience

General Property Repairs

- Doors, windows and fixtures
- Appliances
- Basic plumbing
- Basic electrical
- Minor carpentry and joinery (adjusting doors, hinges, fittings, small woodwork fixes)
- General wear-and-tear maintenance

Hot Tub Maintenance

- Full hot tub changeovers at weekends
- Daily hot tub checks during the week
- Water testing, chemical balancing and cleaning
- Identifying and resolving minor issues

Garden & Exterior Maintenance

- Lawn mowing, strimming and weeding
- Keeping outdoor spaces clean, tidy and well presented
- Exterior upkeep of properties
- Light tidying of terraces, paths and surrounding areas

Property Upkeep

- Light painting and decorating where needed
- Small repairs and adjustments between guest stays

General Chalet Support

- When no maintenance tasks are outstanding, supporting the operations team with cleaning, laundry changeovers and general chalet preparation
- Working professionally around guests and representing the company positively when on site
- Communicating clearly with the wider team throughout the day

Working Pattern

- 30 hours per week
- 1 full day and 2 half days off per week

Flexibility is important, particularly around weekend hot tub changeovers and guest needs. That said, this works both ways — when the workload allows, there is plenty of opportunity to enjoy everything the mountains have to offer over the summer.

Skills & Experience Required

- Solid hands-on property maintenance experience
- Ability to troubleshoot and solve problems independently
- Good judgement about when to repair and when to escalate
- Confident with basic plumbing and electrical repairs

- Some carpentry/joinery experience preferred
- Comfortable working outdoors
- Full manual driving licence valid in Europe
- Good spoken English

Preferable

- Basic/conversational French
- Previous experience maintaining hot tubs or pools
- Previous experience in hospitality property maintenance
- Right to work in France (EU passport or Carte de Séjour)
